Suárez, Murgoitio and Gamonal take stock of 2010 and set goals for 2011

BH-sponsored bikers Isaac Suárez, Egoitz Murgoitio, and Rocío Gamonal take a look back on 2010 and define the challenges they will face in the new year.

Cantabrian Isaac Suárez, of Cantabria Infinita-BH, believes that “2010 had good and bad moments. I’m happy with what I did in the World Championships. I’ve got a lot of second places lately, but until the Cantabria Championship, victory seemed to be evading me. I’ll try to take one step at a time in 2011. First, I’ll ride for victory this weekend in the Spanish Championships, and then, if I happen to take part in them, offer a good show in the World Championships. Then I’ll start from scratch again.”

2010 was a good year for Egoitz Murgoitio, the biker from Vizcaya who defends Grupo Hirumet Taldea’s colours. He expects to grow at the international level in 2011 as he did last year. “I always think the next season will be good, but I know that physically you’re not the same throughout the season. Sometimes you don’t achieve the goals you’d set yourself. On the first days of 2010 I thought I’d take a huge leap in the international scene, and I consider I’ve reached that goal, as reflected in my 11th place in Igorre. Also, I climbed to the top in the Euskadi Championship, which was one of my goals as well. This year, I want to do a good job in the Spanish Championships and do better in international events.”

As to Rocío Gamonal, of Caixanova-BH-Isostar, she considers that 2010 was “a transition year” for her. “The cyclo-cross season was great, with victories in practically all the races, the Spanish Championships and the Spanish Cup. On the contrary, the MTB season was tougher, with my eyes set on the following year, with more races abroad, mainly to check the competition level at the World Cup. This is one of the most important moments in my sporting career, because I’ll try to book a place for the Olympic Games. In March, there’ll be the Spanish Cyclo-Cross Open Championships and several World Cup rounds that can help me get my place in London 2012.”
